



Gretta Waggoner Kistler—NC Zeta Scholarship



The Gretta Waggoner Kistler—NC Zeta Scholarship is awarded annually by the North Carolina Zeta Chapter of Alpha Delta Kappa. Alpha Delta Kappa is an international sorority of women educators. The Zeta Chapter members are primarily teachers within the Charlotte-Mecklenburg School System. Gretta Waggoner Kistler was a retired teacher and supervisor with the Charlotte-Mecklenburg School System and was the first state president of North Carolina Alpha Delta Kappa.

The Gretta Waggoner Kistler—NC Zeta Scholarship is open to any female or male student who is scheduled to graduate from one of the accredited high schools in North Carolina assigned to Zeta Chapter. The applicant is expected to enroll in a four-year college or university in **North Carolina** next fall and must meet eligibility requirements. This scholarship is a one-year, non-renewable scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00 from the NC Zeta Chapter of Alpha Delta Kappa.

I. Eligibility requirements for Applicant

- A. Application submitted to college(s) of choice
- B. Academic rank in top 10% of class
- C. Minimum SAT score of 900 (Combined Math and Language Scores) or ACT composite score of 20
- D. Participation in extra-curricular activities (school and community)
- E. Financial need (not the primary consideration)

II. Data to be submitted

- A. Application
- B. Official sealed transcript (including **first semester senior grades**, SAT and/or ACT scores, cumulative numerical academic average and rank in class)
- C. Two sealed letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a teacher that you have had for a class; one from another adult of the applicant's choosing (another teacher, guidance counselor, coach, pastor, supervisor, or other qualified individual. The letter should outline character traits, special talents and abilities, examples of leadership and service, etc., of the applicant.
- D. Recent picture, optional.
- E. Letter from applicant stating her/his plans, career goals, and reasons for wanting the scholarship
- F. Recommended format for applicant's letter and letters of recommendation
 - Inside Address: Gretta Waggoner Kistler—NC Zeta Scholarship
 - North Carolina Alpha Delta Kappa, Zeta Chapter
 - Salutation: Dear Committee Members

III. Procedures for applying

- A. Meet all eligibility requirements
- B. Submit ALL requested data by deadline of **April 22, 2015**
- C. Agree to be available for an interview, if requested

IV. Information on the scholarship recipient's obligations

- A. Recipient can receive another scholarship for the time covered by this scholarship; however, should a full scholarship be received by the applicant, the recipient must notify the Zeta Chapter Scholarship Chairman and relinquish this scholarship.
- B. In the event the recipient decides to attend a college/university outside North Carolina, the recipient will no longer be eligible for this scholarship.
- C. If the recipient withdraws from school during the freshman year, the recipient must notify the Zeta Chapter Scholarship Chairman. At that time, any remaining scholarship funds would be relinquished.
